Group: Easy Does It

Motion: Any motion regarding a change in policy must be read @ 2 consecutive ASC meetings and voted on @ the third.

Intent: Let all groups have a fair opportunity to hear and understand the motion prior to vote.

For: 7 Against: 12 Abstain: 13

Group: Never Alone

Motion: To grandfather current convention committee chairperson and co-chair.

Intent: To allow the, to fulfill their commitments.

This motion was objected to after the June ASC meeting. After brief discussions surrounding the validity of this motion, a group conscious was taken on whether or not to proceed with the voting on this particular motion. There were 24 abstentions. 10 groups voted against collecting the votes. 2 groups possibly wished to proceed. By this count, this motion was decided to be invalid and no further vote was collected.

Group: Gift of Life

Motion: That there be a moratorium of 5 years for convention!

Intent: The 6th Tradition, “lend the NA name, to NA problems of money, property, + prestige” is diverting us from primary purpose.

Rescinded. See below motion to rescind presented by the Gift of Life group.

Group: Easy Does It

Motion: Any revision in policy regarding a change in clean time requirement for trusted servants will not affect those currently serving.

Intent: To allow trusted servants currently serving a position to fulfill their commitment as voted on by area.

Tabled until August ASC meeting. The meeting came to a sudden close before the vote could be counted.
